Vermont Headband

The pattern has kindly been translated to english by Kalina Vanderhoff

Size: One size

Measurements: 31/4 inches = 8cm x desired circumference

Materials:

About 25g Filcolana Indiecita (Fingering/14ply; 100% alpaca; 175 yards/50 grams)

About 10g Filcolana Tilia (Lace; 70% mohair, 30% silk; 213 yards/25 grams)

- the two yarns knit together

Needles: Size 7 US = (4,5mm) + Cable needle

Gauge: 20 sts/26 rows per 4"/10cm in stockinette stitch

Cast on 19 stitches with the two yarns held together on Size 7 US needles.

Knit back and forth.

Row 1 (wrong side): K5 - P9 - K5.

Row 2: Knit to end of row.

Row 3: Repeat Row 1.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

Row 5: Repeat Row 1.

Row 6: K5 - place 3 sts on cable needle - hold to front of work - K3 - knit 3 sts from cable needle -

K8.

Row 7: Repeat Row 1.

Row 8: Repeat Row 2.

Row 9: Repeat Row 1.

Row 10: K8 - place 3 sts on cable needle - hold to back of work - K3 - knit 3 sts from cable needle

Repeat Rows 3-10 until desired length.

The knitted length must be less than head circumference.

I have knit 19" which fits 22" head circumference.

Bind off.

Sew cast on and bind off edges together.

Stitch Abrreviations:

K = Knit

P = Purl

sts = stitches
